Blue Ocean Capital, a company that invests in the European port industry, has gained a new partner in the form of Tommy Mølgaard.

Mølgaard has more than 25 years of experience with ports, logistics and the maritime industry, and he has worked in Europe, the Middle East and the Far East. He has also been global chief financial officer at Damco, which was integrated into Maersk Line in 2018.

Here, Mølgaard was CFO for four years until 2017, when he left A.P. Møller-Mærsk and became CFO at foods company Danish Crown's UK subsidiary Tulip Limited.

Jakob Ingemann Olsen is the investment firm's chief executive and also has history with Maersk, among other shipping companies.
